Fund objective

The US dollar Blue Chip fund aims to provide the potential for medium-to-long-term growth and invests in equities and a proportion of fixed-interest securities. The risk profile of this investment choice is the middle of the five managed funds.

This investment choice is a portfolio internally managed by Zurich on a discretionary basis. The investment policy is overseen by Columbia Threadneedle Investments according to investment mandates set and controlled by Zurich.

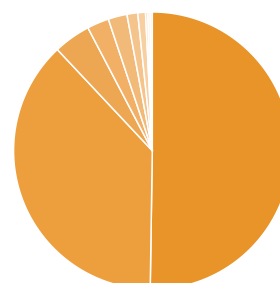
Fund commentary (as at 31/12/2023)

A sizeable portion of the portfolio is invested in US equities and government bonds, with an emphasis on the former. It was a good quarter for both asset classes. Throughout the period, the US Federal Reserve held interest rates steady at a target of 5.25%-5.50%. However, a continued easing of inflationary pressures and some cooling of the labour market should pave the way for interest-rate cuts in 2024. Following their recent strong performance, we realised some gains on US equities, switching a large part of the proceeds into US government bonds. However, we also added to our US equity income strategy. Additionally, within the equity allocation, we reduced exposure to the UK and a global fund but increased continental Europe.

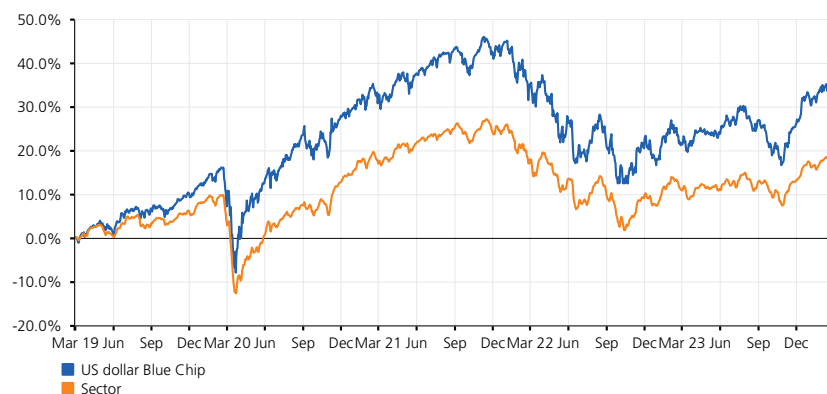
